Aktuelle Themen der Niederlandistik

This lecture explores contemporary assertions of the self in Afrikaans. It does so from the combined perspectives of narrative identity developed by Paul Ricoeur as well as intersubjective accounts of the self and notions of recognition, redistribution, and participation, proposed in contemporary critical theory by Seyla Benhabib, Nancy Fraser, and Axel Honneth. Excerpts from selected texts are examined to show how a range of presentations of the self in Afrikaans are mobilized in still unfinished struggles for recognition, redistribution and participation.
